1. The administrator of personal data of candidates and qualified students is the University of Warsaw represented by the Rector, based at Krakowskie Przedmieście 26/28, 00-927 Warsaw, Poland. 2. The administrator has appointed a Data Protection Inspector (IOD), who can be reached at this email address: iod@adm.uw.edu.pl. The IOD can be contacted in all matters regarding the processing of data by the University of Warsaw and the use of data processing rights.
3. The personal data of candidates and qualified students will be processed for the purpose of participation in the Erasmus+ program.
4. Candidates' agreement constitutes the grounds for the processing of their data. Data of qualified students will be processed according to the agreement between the University of Warsaw and the Foundation for the Development of the Education System – National Agency as well as Regulation (EU) No 1288/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 establishing 'Erasmus+'; the Union program for education, training, youth and sport and repealing Decisions No 1719/2006/EC, No 1720/2006/EC and No 1298/2008/EC Text with EEA relevance.
5. While the provision of candidates' personal data is voluntary, failure to provide them will exclude them from the qualification process. The provision of personal data of qualified students is obligatory and failure to provide them will exclude them from scholarship.
6. Access to personal data will be available to the Foundation for the Development of the Education System (Erasmus+ program operator in Poland) and the receiving institution where the student was qualified. Recipients of personal data may also include the entities authorized by law.
